LATEST NEWS UPDATE

Charis Village board members were in attendance at the Lacombe City Council meeting on December 18, 2017. City Council unanimously approved the 2018 Capital Budget which includes funding for the engineering/ design of the Henner's Pond stormwater outlet, including the funds for land and Right of Way acquisition.

A Request for Proposal (RFP) for engineering services is being prepared and will be issued by the end of January. The due date for the RFP is early February with work to be initiated and underway by the end of February/ early March. City of Lacombe wants the engineering firm engaged and then will meet with Alberta Environment regarding the stormwater outlet program.
