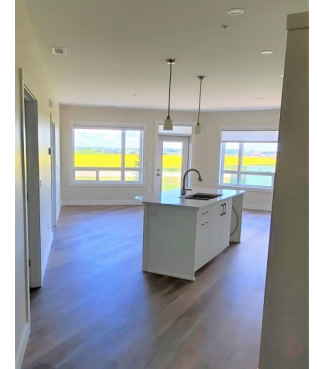
COMMUNITY BUILDING
