After attending Portland State University I moved to Los Angeles. I worked at Hewlett Packard as a Credit Analyst handling all government contract purchases. I traveled on-site to all Air Force, Naval & National Defense bases to sometimes track down computer components not properly signed off at the time of arriving on their dock. I was re-acquainted with Ron Huisman after 50+ years as he was always part of my family when we were children. In 2001 I moved to Beiseker, AB to be with Ron and help him at the Huisman Farm.
